Gates open 2 ½ hrs prior to the first race but never any earlier than 10.00am.

**ABANDONMENT** - As a racecourse which operates throughout the Winter months, Wetherby fully appreciates the risk that the weather can occasionally pose to a race meeting. Therefore, a clear abandonment policy is adopted as follows:

Before the 1st race - Full Refund  
Before the 3rd race - 50% Refund  
After the 3rd race - No Refund

Our full abandonment refund policy is detailed on our website.

**BAGS** – As part of our Security protocols, we carry out random bag searches on entry.

**CAMERAS** - You are welcome to take photographs with phones or small compact cameras. Amateur photographers using professional level equipment will be asked to sign a photography permit on entry. Flash photography is prohibited.

**CAR PARKING** is provided within the Racecourse grounds and is FREE of charge. Directional parking signage is displayed, and car park attendants are on hand to assist you. Racegoers can also pay to park in the centre of our course. Our 'Cars to Course' admission allows one car and up to 4 adults entry to the Course Enclosure. Coach Parking is also available.

**CASH** is no longer accepted at the turnstiles; Daily admission is now by card payment only. Cash is still accepted in all other areas, but we would encourage contactless card payment wherever possible. A cash machine is available in both the Premier and Paddock enclosure. Tote windows also provide a cash-back facility.

**CHILDREN** aged 17 years of age and under must be accompanied by an adult and are admitted FREE to all Enclosures. Proof of age may be requested.

**COACHES** Parking for coaches is provided within the Racecourse Grounds. On busy days, our overflow coach parking is utilised at the lower end of the car parks, and this now has a lit pedestrian pathway linking it to the turnstile entrances. Stewards will direct coaches and pedestrians on arrival and exit.

Complimentary Paddock admission will be provided for coach drivers on production of their Driver Manifest at the Information Point.

**CONCESSIONS** We provide a £5 concession discount for racegoers aged 66 and over and for students, into either the Premier or Paddock Enclosures and £3 discount into the Course Enclosure. Proof of eligibility may be requested. Discounts are available online in advance of the meeting or on the day (Card payment only)

**DISABLED RACEGOERS** We do not provide an entry discount to disabled racegoers, however if a disability requires a racegoer to be accompanied to, and at the races, by a registered carer, then the carer will receive complimentary admission. Proof of the disabled persons eligibility may be required. Full details are contained within the FAQ section of our website.

**DOGS** (except registered guide dogs) are not admitted into any of our Enclosures on racedays.

**DRESS CODE** - Wetherby does not operate a formal dress code in any of the Enclosures. Racegoers who wish to use the Premier Enclosure are kindly requested to wear smart casual clothing.

**E-TICKETS** – The majority of our advance sale admissions are now administered by E-Ticket. Please check your order confirmation and ensure you have your E-ticket printed off or ready to scan from your mobile device on entry and that you are accessing the Racecourse via your designated E-Ticket entry point.

**FOOD & DRINK** is not permitted to be brought into either our Premier or Paddock Enclosures except for snacks for those with specific dietary requirements and with small children.

Racegoers may take picnics including a small quantity of alcohol for personal consumption into the Course Enclosure (No Glass Bottles please).

**OPENING TIMES** Our gates and all facilities open 2-2 ½ hours in advance of the first race but never before 10.00am. Opening times can be viewed on our website and may be subject to change as race times change.

**REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS** under our terms and conditions, tickets purchased are non-transferable and non-refundable.

**SMOKING** (including E-Cigarettes) is not permitted within any of our buildings, grandstand areas, balconies, and temporary structures. Smoking is allowed in open outdoor areas.
